

## MEDIA PARTNER / RECOGNITION CHAMPION EVENT QUESTIONS:

- **When will the JKO Grassroot Jefferson Award recipients be announced?**
  - We will announce the JKO Grassroot winner at the Multiplying Good Community Dinner, June 23 in Indianapolis.
- **When will the Outstanding Public Service by an Employee be announced?**
  - We will announce the Outstanding Public Service by and Employee winner at the Multiplying Good Community Dinner, June 23 in Indianapolis.
- **Why is Multiplying Good having two events in 2022?**
  - Multiplying Good typically has two events each year – our NYC Gala and the Jefferson Awards in Washington DC. This year, as we celebrate 50 years, we have made some adjustments to our two annual events.
- **What is the purpose of the Indianapolis event?**
  - This year we will gather all of our constituents in one of our Leadership Communities with a focus on Community Building. We have heard from our recipients across all programs that being with each other in community, doing service and in celebration was important.
- **Will my recipient be recognized at the Indianapolis event?**
  - Yes, recipients will be recognized throughout the event
- **What is the agenda for the Indianapolis event?**
  - The agenda will include 1-min speeches, service projects, workshops and training opportunities as well as a celebration of all our recipients.
- **Will my recipient have an opportunity to share their 1-minute speech in Indianapolis?**
  - Yes! Just as we have done in Washington, DC, we will host all our recipients onstage for their 1-Minute speeches during breakfast on Wednesday, June 22.
- **Will I receive content around my recipient's experience in Indianapolis? (Photos, 1-minute videos, B-Roll, etc)**
  - Yes, in addition to the 1-Minute speech recordings, we will be gathering content during the three days that will be shared back to our partners.

## **MEDIA PARTNER / RECOGNITION CHAMPION EVENT QUESTIONS:**

- **When will my recipient be contacted by Multiplying Good? What will my recipient receive when they are contacted by Multiplying Good?**
  - As in past years recipient names are due to us by April 1. MG will then reach out to each recipient with information about travel and accommodations as well as answer any questions they may have. MG will gather bios and photos and may inquire about additional content we can use to celebrate your recipient. In addition MG will provide itinerary's and additional information that will help with your recipients experience at our June event.
- **My judging will not take place until mid-April, may I have an extension?**

- **What is the difference between the Indianapolis event and the NYC event in November?**
  - Our June event will focus on community building and provide opportunities for our constituents to engage with each other and multiply good across one of our local communities. While there will be a celebration piece included, the Jefferson Awards will not be presented at this event. The Jefferson Awards will be presented at our 50th celebration in NYC. There we will honor our grassroots winners along with our National winners.
- **Who pays the cost of travel for the NYC event?**
  - Multiplying Good will cover the costs of our 5 JKO winners and Top Employees to attend the Jefferson Awards in NY where they will be presented with their medallion.
- **If my recipient is selected to receive a National Jefferson Award, when and how will it be presented?**
  - The National Jefferson Award winners will be awarded at our 50th Annual event in New York City on November 2. Winners will be provided with all pertinent information following the announcement at the June event in Indianapolis.

## **STUDENTS IN ACTION (SIA) EVENT QUESTIONS:**

- **What is the final date that National will need to know who our LC winner is?**
  - Information regarding our Winners from our LC's should be provided to the national office no later than May 21st. All travel arrangements and hotel bookings must be complete by 6/5/2022.
- **How many students/Advisors will MG pay to attend the June event?**
  - Multiplying Good covers, the cost of 2 students and 1 Faculty member to attend from each winning LC team. (double occupancy) Additional members team members can attend at their own cost.
- **Will there be a service component as part of the June event?**
  - YES! Service and community building are top priorities of this event.
- **Is this the June event the "DC event?"**
  - No. Our June event will be focused on building community whereas our DC event historically has been centered around celebration.
- **Will SIA teams who were winners in 2020 and 2021 (while virtual) be recognized?**
  - Yes, during our time in Indianapolis we will celebrate all of our virtual winners.
- **Is this where we would recognize LC winner for PSPD/National winners? Or is that in November 50th gala?**
  - During our gathering in June, we will recognize our top schools from each Local Community and they will be presented with their plaques. We also will identify our gold, silver and bronze school. Our Gold school will join us in NYC to receive their Jefferson Award.
