### GRADUATION PATHWAYS

Students in Action integrates academic study with service experience, reflects larger social, economic, and societal issues, and collaborative efforts between students, schools, and community partners.

## WHAT IS SIA?

### REGULAR TEAM MEETINGS

SIA participants meet regularly as part of a class, club, or group—supported by MG staff and volunteers—to plan and execute at least one high-quality service project.

### LEADERSHIP TRAINING CONFERENCES

Participants come together twice a year at conferences where they build skills, meet new people, and have a great time learning and networking!

### CELEBRATION WITH THE JEFFERSON AWARD

Each spring, participants present their service work at an End-of-Year Celebration event, gaining the chance to receive local and potentially national recognition through the Jefferson Awards.

## A DEEPLY SUPPORTED MODEL

SIA Teams receive deep levels of support and guidance in order to help them multiply good.

### ON-THE-GROUND STAFF

In every community where we operate, program managers support SIA teams in executing against the goals of the program.

### COMMUNITY COACHES

SIA teams are connected with coaches from the community and/or through corporate partners. Coaches connect monthly with teams to help them troubleshoot issues and think big.

### FACULTY ADVISORS

All teams are supported by an advisor at the school-level. Advisors can be teachers, administrators or other school staff members.

The Students In Action program is offered **FREE OF CHARGE** to all participants, regardless of their ability to pay. There are no program fees required of schools, districts, or families in order for their students to participate. Multiplying Good relies on the generosity of donors and grantors to provide SIA in your community, bringing young people together to foster mutual understanding, break down stereotypes, and build a generation of service leaders.
