- Create, train, and distribute development reports
- Maintain accurate records, safeguarding the confidentiality of contacts as necessary



- Provide ready access to data and prospects to development staff
- Prepare, maintain and update development records

- Support organizational leadership in preparing for fundraising meetings, presentations, and events, including managing invitations, briefings and follow up notes
- Assist in strategy, planning, coordination, and implementation of high-level national donor events

- Support Development staff with building and executing against revenue pipelines, based on reporting
